1. The grievance being raised by the petitioners is that prior to the date when the petitioners retired, their claim for promotion has already been considered and they were also found eligible but only 16 promotions were made by the respondent-Department, which is causing prejudice as, the post for promotion was even available for the petitioners, which fact has not been considered by the respondents and the petitioners are suffering hence, the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Senior Assistant against the vacancies, which were available to them so as to release all consequential financial and retired benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-14) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
