1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 30.01.2025 (Annexure P-10) whereby respondent has sanctioned Rs.12,046/- against medical bill of Rs.1,33,686/-.

2. The petitioner is claiming that he is serving in Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited as Assistant Sub Station Attendant. His wife delivered a girl child on 21.07.2024. She was subjected to cesarean, thus, a sum of Rs.1,33,686/- was incurred at the time of delivery. He lodged his medical claim for reimbursement, however, respondent sanctioned minuscule amount i.e. Rs.12,046/-. He filed representation with higher authorities. SDO (Operation) DHBVNL, Safidon has forwarded the matter to XEN (Operation). The said authority is sitting over the matter.



- 3. Mr. S.S. Mor, Advocate for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide his representation.
- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
- 6. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
- 7. Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate submits that Competent Authority would address representation dated 20.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within two months from today.
- 8. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
