1. The challenge is to the order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 29.04.2025, whereby the learned Single Judge has dismissed the writ petition filed by the appellant challenging her transfer as Deputy Superintendent Class-C, from Govt. College, Ambala Cantt. to Govt. College, Jind.

2. Her submissions relating to her mother suffering from chronic heart disease, multiple sclerosis, Type-1 diabetes, were examined by the learned Single Judge and found that the same was not one of the aspects to be taken into consideration for the purpose of transfer under the transfer drive policy dated 07.02.2022. It was also found that there was no provision for giving points for chronic disease of dependent mother. Accordingly, the appellant's request was declined.

3. Learned counsel submits that the appellant ought to have been allowed to continue as her mother is ailing. There is no other reason coming forward.

4. We find that the appellant herself participated in the transfer drive and submitted her first option as Govt. College, Jind, where she has now been transferred. Thus, her first option has been accepted. We also notice that Jind is also 140 kms away from Ambala with connecting road and, therefore, it cannot be said to be a reason to disturb or set aside the transfer order.

5. The order passed by the learned Single Judge is accordingly upheld. The appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.

6. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
