The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.122 dated 11.04.2025 under Sections 305 of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Line Par Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 11.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 15.09.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for the grant of anticipatory bail. He, however, on instructions

submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 11.08.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, as the petitioner has joined the investigation and the allegations are not such that would require the custodial interrogation of the petitioner, the interim order dated 11.08.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

The petition stands disposed of.
