This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of orders dated 24.4.2024 (Annexure P-1) vide which the application filed under section 391 CrPC for leading additional evidence by the petitioner in criminal appeal bearing no CRA/155/2019 dated 10.12.2019 titled as 'Sandeep Singh versus Lakhbir Singh' before Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran arising out of complaint bearing no NACT/136/2018 dated 13.4.2018 filed under section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 decided by Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Tarn Taran vide its judgment dated 18.11.2019, stands dismissed by Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, illegally.

A perusal of the order sheets reveals that since August, 2024 counsel for the petitioner has availed four opportunities to



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comply with the directions issued by Co-ordinate Bench on 27.05.2024 and today there is yet another request for adjournment has been sought by counsel appearing for the petitioner without any justifiable reason.

This Court do not find any reason to adjourn the matter further and deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition for want of prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
