JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to revise his pension and other retiral benefits.

2. The petitioner claims that he retired on 30.06.2022 and respondent enhanced dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2022. In view of law laid down by Supreme Court in *Director (Admn. and HR) KPTCL and others vs. C.P. Mundinamani and others, 2023 SCC OnLine SC 401*, he is entitled to revised dearness allowance. He has sent representation to respondent which was followed by legal notice but to no avail.

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- 3. Mr. Pranav Chadha, Advocate, who on advance is present in Court, submits that competent authority would look into representations of the petitioner and address the same within 8 weeks from today.
- 4. Mr. Sukhdeep S. Chhatwal, Advocate agrees with the aforesaid arrangement.
- 5. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of.
