The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, through SPA dated 07.09.2022, seeking quashing/setting aside the order dated 16.02.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Trial Court, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.37 dated 31.03.2015 registered under Sections 498-A & 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.
