AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together.
2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is claiming promotion to the post of Naib Teshsildar w.e.f. 21.03.1996, the date on which respondent No.5 had been promoted, who was junior to him, and for quashing the orders whereby seniority granted to the petitioner over and above the aforesaid respondent, was reviewed. During pendency of this case, his seniority has since been upheld by this Court to be above the aforesaid respondent in CWP-4591-1996, decided on 27.04.2016 holding that seniority that was of the District Bathinda would be the basis for determining that in the newly carved out District Mansa. Thus, he prays his case be re-considered for promotion as Naib Tehsildar, taking into consideration the aforesaid, in a time bound manner.

3. The aforesaid facts having been brought out, during the course of hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the respondents would not be averse to have a relook at the matter and decide afresh, taking note of the aforesaid submissions, within a period of 4 months, uninfluenced by the order impugned in the present case, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner.

4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. The matter stands disposed of accordingly and if the petitioner is found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same may be passed after granting opportunity of hearing to him and shall contain reasons, whereupon he shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
