At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer for quashing of the order dated 23.01.2018 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridkot, titled as '*State vs. Sukhwant Singh and Others*' in case FIR No.121 dated 29.08.2013 registered under Sections 457, 380 IPC P.S. Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had no intention to evade the legal proceedings and has never deliberately avoided the process of law. He submits that the petitioner went abroad under the impression that he will be represented by his counsel. A request is made that the petitioner would surrender within a week from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.



Having considered the submissions made, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender within a week from today and apply for regular bail. On doing so, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible. In case the petitioner fails to surrender within a week, this order shall stand vacated automatically without reference to the Court.
