1. Prayer made in the present petition for quashing of selection of respondent Nos.4 and 5 for the post of Homeopathic Dispenser, might not due to efflux of time, even be surviving, especially in wake of there being no interim order.

2. Learned State counsel on the other hand while referring to the counter affidavit dated 17.01.2011 filed by Additional Secretary, Health-cum-Head of the Homeopathic Department, Punjab states that the petitioner was not considered for the post in question, being over age and even after grant of relaxation of 10 years as per the guidelines, he being 50 years, while the age limit was 35 years. However, the private respondents were selected after the State Government had granted relaxation of conditions for qualifying/securing 50% marks to candidates

of all categories.

3.               Disposed of, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to get it revived, by demonstrating that the *lis* still survives.
