Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to get released the detenues, namely Ankita (daughter of petitioner), Lovepreet Singh and Fatehveer (minor sons of Ankita), from the illegal detention of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the status report by way of affidavit of Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place.

Learned State counsel while referring to the aforementioned status report submits that applicant is the mother of the detinue and detinue-Ankita has made a statement as well as given an affidavit, which is available on record as Annexures R-1 and R-2 respectively, in which she has submitted that she is major of 23 years age and she categorically stated that after the death of her husband-Jagpreet Singh, she has now performed marriage with Parvinder Singh and is living happily with him as his legally wedded wife. State counsel further submits that present petition has been filed on false and frivolous grounds.

In view of the aforesaid status report and also the submission made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
