The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release second and third ACP grades to the petitioner along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 30.03.2025, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 30.03.2025, will be decided by the second respondent/Director General, School Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
