The instant Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-12) passed in ROR No.624 of 2024.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the parties in the partition proceedings have not been impleaded as party in the instant writ petition.

2.1 Learned counsel further submits that even the translation of the complete document especially revenue record/*jamabandi* has not been attached, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one with better particulars.
