This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside order dated 14.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab.

2. A perusal of the order sheets reveals that on 28.07.2025, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks time to place on record the site plan indicating the position emanating from the final partition.
