Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against respondents No.4 and 5 for causing any harassment to the petitioners by illegally detaining/restraining them into various police stations without any criminal case against them, along with further prayer to direct the respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 10.04.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that a criminal case under the provisions of NDPS Act was registered against Navkaran Singh-son of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 because of which the petitioners are being harassed by the police despite their having already disowned their son. Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners filed representation dated 20.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No.3, but till date no action has been taken.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners stated that he would be satisfied, in case, the pending representation (Annexure P-2) is decided by respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 20.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) is decided.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to look into the representation (Annexure P2) and to take appropriate action, if any required, at the earliest.
