The instant revision petition has been preferred against the judgment dated 04.11.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, whereby the sentence awarded to the private respondents by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal vide judgment of conviction dated 26.09.2011 and order of sentence dated 28.09.2011 was set aside and the accused were released on probation on account of good conduct.
