RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J (ORAL)

1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of an FIR No.0010 dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station PS NRI, District Bathinda and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 20.05.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 04.07.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 25.07.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.



4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.0010 dated 11.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station PS NRI, District Bathinda and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/settlement dated 20.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of, accordingly.
