[1] The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*Mandamus*' directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6.

[2] Notice of motion.

[3] On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ramta Chowdhary, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 3-State and submits that representation dated 02.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) has been received, whereupon, statement of respondent No.4-Raj Kumar, who is father of petitioner No.1-Ekta Rani has been recorded by the Station House Officer, P.S. City Sri Muktsar Sahib and as per the said statement, respondent No.4 has no objection from the matrimonial relationship *inter se* the petitioners. It is further confirmed by learned State counsel that both the petitioners are major.

[4] Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Station House Officer, Police Station City, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No. 3) in case they



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persist any further apprehension, at the hands of private respondents
No.4 to 6.

[5] Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand
disposed of.
