1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the BSE Nursing Registration Number be issued to the petitioner so that the petitioner can apply in respect of the Advertisement dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) to be selected as Nursing Officers (Group-B Post) issued by the Director Principal, Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32-B, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Registration Number is not being given to the petitioner which would result in ousting of

the petitioner from the zone of consideration to the said post and the petitioner will suffer prejudice in case, after the expiry of the last date to apply i.e. 07.05.2025, mentioned in the Advertisement dated 09.04.2025, the Registration Number is given to the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate accepted notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and Mr. Aman Pal, Advocate and Mr. Rakesh Sobti, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner for the issuance of the Registration Number will be considered by the respondent No.2-Punjab Nursing Registration Council today itself and in case, the petitioner fulfils the requisites for the grant of the Registration Number, the same will be given by 12 noon tomorrow and in case, the petitioner is not found entitled for the grant of said benefit, due speaking order will be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent No.2 submits that the form on the basis of which, the eligibility of the petitioner is to be adjudged is with the petitioner and the same be supplied.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the copy of the form will be supplied to Mr. Kalra, Advocate for respondent No.2 within a period of 10 minutes today itself.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping in view the fact that the respondents have undertaken to consider the claim

of the petitioner for the grant of Registration Number by the Punjab Nursing Registration Council, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, at this stage.
