1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking permission to visit Hong Kong and China from 25.05.2025 to 15.05.2025. However, subsequently, the petitioner has moved an application bearing number **CRM-28407-2025** making request to consider his prayer for grant of aforesaid permission qua his travel from 10.08.2025 to 31.08.2025, instead of the dates mentioned above.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent has filed a criminal complaint against the petitioner, bearing number COMI-54-2018, titled as **Shiv Kumar Goyal vs. Vijay Kumar Goyal & others**, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 ad 120-B of IPC, which is pending before the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jagraon. However, vide order dated 03.05.2019 passed by this Court in **CRM-M-18236-2019**, the proceedings before the trial Court in respect of the aforesaid complaint have been stayed. It is further submitted that the petitioner is the Director of M/s Ricela Health Foods Limited and he has to

go to Hong Kong and China for some business purpose for three weeks i.e. from 10.08.2025 to 31.08.2025.

3. It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier also, the petitioner has been granted permission by this Court to travel abroad i.e. China from 20.06.2019 to 30.06.2019, vide order dated 13.06.2019 passed in **CRM-M-26131-2019**. The petitioner had also sought permission to visit Australia from 04.11.2019 to 25.11.2019, which was granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.11.2019 passed in **CRM-M-46176-2019**. Recently, he was permitted to visit Tanzania and Dubai from 28.07.2024 to 20.08.2024, vide order dated 23.07.2024 passed in **CRM-M-33964-2024**. He has never misused the aforesaid concession and has always returned back to India within the stipulated time. It is, thus, argued that the petition deserves to be allowed and the petitioner deserves to be granted permission as prayed for by him.

4. There is no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is permitted to visit Hong Kong and China from 10.08.2025 to 31.08.2025, subject to his furnishing bank guarantee of Rs. 5 Lakhs before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate before leaving the country. It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to return to India on or before 01.09.2025, the bank guarantee shall be forfeited to the complainant.
