1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (erstwhile Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.179 dated 19.08.2024, registered under Sections 115, 109(1), 190, 191(3), 333, 351(3), 61(2), 238(b) of the BNS, 2023 and Sections 25(1b)(A), 27-54-59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner pray for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate bail application and also pray that the trial Court may be directed to decide his bail application in a time bound manner.

4. Allowed to do so.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and files an appropriate application for bail, then the trial Court shall decide the same within a period of seven days from the date of filing thereof, in accordance with law.
