Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.104 dated 24.05.2024, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. dated 26.08.2024 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to raise all his grievances before the trial Court at relevant time. However, he submits that petitioner No.1 is blind and his personal appearance before the trial Court may be exempted.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case, petitioner No.1 files appropriate application for exemption from his personal appearance before the trial Court, the same be considered by the trial Court sympathetically.
