This is a petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 493 dated 24.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 27, 54 of Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 148, 149 IPC deleted and 427 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Jind City, Jind, District Jind, Haryana.

2. This Court, vide order dated 20.05.2025, had directed the petitioners to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined and

cooperated with the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajender states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.05.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
