1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to the respondents to decide the application dated 12.04.2025 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the wife of the petitioner with a prayer to grant parole for a period of 04 weeks to the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the wife of the present petitioner has moved the aforesaid application before the respondents on 12.04.2025 for granting benefit of parole to the petitioner for the aforementioned period but the same is still pending and no decision has been taken thereon. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to the respondents to decide the aforesaid application and take necessary action.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Apoorv Garg, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful shall be done in due course.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the aforesaid application (Annexure P-4) submitted by the wife of the petitioner within a period of one month from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
