By way of this common judgement, **CWP-13225-2024, CWP-18308-2024, CWP-18311-2024, CWP-17707-2024, CWP-20356-2024, CWP-21071-2024, CWP-21076-2024, CWP-21726-2024 and CWP-22099-2024** shall be disposed of as they are similar and connected.

This petition along with the connected matters was filed by different minority institutions conducting courses including the course in Diploma in Elementary Education. The contention of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners is that the State had declined registration of the students in the said Course despite the Division Bench judgement dated 22.02.2024 rendered in CWP-20342-2023 (Haryana Self-Finance Private Colleges Association vs. The State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) Haryana and others, quashing the decision taken by State of Haryana dated 07.11.2022.

This Court in CWP-13225-2024 by an interim order dated 22.7.2024, permitted the students of petitioner(s) Colleges to provisionally appear in the first year examination of D.El.Ed course. Learned counsel for State informs the Court that in COCP No.2111 of 2024 (Court on its motion Vs. Sunil Bajaj Director State Council of Educational Research and Training, Hry Gurgaon) unconditional apology tendered by the State Functionary was accepted by the contempt Court and contempt petition was disposed of vide order dated 12.11.2024. In that order, as per the submission of the respondent

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therein, the candidates who were given admission for the academic session 2023-25 by the Minority institutions; have been permitted to appear in the examination with the rider that results shall be declared subject to verification of their minimum educational qualifications required for admission to D.El.Ed course. It was further submitted that the admission process for the academic session 2024-26 is in progress.

Counsel for the State of Haryana informs that the verification process is over and credentials of the students who have been provisionally admitted have been verified.

In view of the aforesaid, it would be appropriate that the competent authority of the State of Haryana takes further steps so that the eligible students who were admitted provisionally can continue with their studies in accordance with norms.

Accordingly, all connected writ petitions stand disposed of.

Results of the eligible students who have been provisionally admitted in the academic session 2023-25 be declared if the same has been prepared.
