Present petition herein is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent authorities to issue allotment of residential plots to the petitioners as per their entitlement and further direct the respondents authorities to decide the Legal Notices dated 12.02.2024 (Annexures P-6 & P-7).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already served Legal Notices dated 12.02.2024 (Annexures P-6 & P-7) to the respondents-competent authority for redressal of their grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to



deal with their concerns/grievances and pass an appropriate order on the said Legal Notices.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Kuljit Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab appears on behalf of respondents and submits that the said legal notices shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 (competent authority) i.e. Estate Officer, GMADA to consider pending legal notices dated 12.02.2024 (Annexures P-6 & P-7) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
