1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members who are apprehending danger at the behest of respondent nos.4 to 12 and also to decide his representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the father of the petitioner has filed a Civil Suit before the trial Court, which is pending adjudication. He submits that despite there being no case pending against the petitioner and his family members, the respondent-police officials have illegally harassed and arrested them, though they were released lateron. He submits that the respondent-police officials are continuing extending threats to the petitioner and his family members without there being any fault on their part. It is submitted that the petitioner and his family members have submitted a representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) and dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent nos.2 & 3 but no action has been taken till date.

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3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and his family members, in accordance with law, and grant them protection, if any threat to their lives and liberty is perceived.
6. It is clarified that this order shall not be deemed to have granted any immunity to the petitioner and his family members from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
