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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to respondents No. 2 to 6 to conduct detailed inquiry against respondent No. 8 as regards allegation of embezzlement of gram panchayat funds and other irregularities committed by respondent No. 8, while discharging duties.

2. Learned State counsel, in pursuance to the advance copy of the petition having been served upon the State, appears on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6 and on instructions from Ms. Pooja Sharma, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad, submits that the complaints submitted by the petitioners have already been inquired into and the matter is pending consideration before the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad, however, final order is yet to be passed thereon. He submits that if petitioners have any grievance, they may appear before the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad and put-forth their stand.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, learned counsel for petitioners prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad, in consonance with the stand taken by learned State counsel.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
