AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for respondent No.5-College states that vide order dated 28.07.2017, Annexure R-5/6, claim of the petitioner has been forwarded to the Director Agriculture on account of the fact that she is not an employee of the College, though recommended by them, appointed by the State in the farmer training centre situated within the premises of the College.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel, on instructions, prays that a direction may given to respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the claim of the petitioner in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the claim of the petitioner, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to her and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
