Challenge raised in present writ petition is to the order dated 04.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Chandigarh to Khajuraho Airport, Madhya Pradesh, as well as the relieving order dated 26.04.2025 vide which the petitioner has been directed to be relieved on 10.05.2025.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this juncture the petitioner(s) would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the competent authority to decide the representation dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) sent by him by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

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3 Notice of motion.

4 Ms. Gurmeet Kaur Gill, Senior Panel Counsel for Union of India enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, CISF, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, to decide the representation dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
