1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.3-Divisional Commissioner, Karnal to decide the application filed by the petitioner for grant of regular parole of 10 weeks expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no action has been taken on the representation of the petitioner dated 19.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) till date. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by respondent No.3 by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.
