Challenge in the present petition is to the letter dated 12.2.2020 (Annexure P-4) vide which the bank demanded lumpsum recovery from the family pension of the petitioner amounting to Rs.18,91,036/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has passed away. He further submits that despite best efforts, there is no response or communication from the LR's of the petitioner. The house was found to be closed as well.

It seems that the LR's of the petitioner may not be interested in pursuing the present writ petition any further.

Dismissed for non prosecution.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner's LR's to seek revival of the present writ petition in case any grievance still survives.
