1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue direction to respondent No.4 not to conduct multiple enquiry on various complaints moved by respondent No.5.

On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh submits that all the complaints in the present case have been ordered to be filed and no enquiry is pending with the police authorities. He further submits that it has been found that there was breach of peace in the area and the preventive action is being initiated against both the parties.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed of.
