1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 'Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita', 2023, for quashing of FIR No. 0020, dated 09.02.2025, registered at Police Station Satnampura Phagwara, District Kapurthala, under Sections 140(3), 305, 324, 191(3), 190, and 331(4) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS') and Sections 25, 25(6) and 25(7) of the Arms Act, 1959, on the basis of a compromise deed, dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset submits that all the accused included in the FIR(supra) have not been impleaded as petitioners in the present petition and partial compromise is not permissible in view of the reference answered by the Division Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48043-2023 decided on 12.11.2024 titled as '*Rakesh Das Vs. State of Haryana and Another*'.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition after impleading all the stake holders.

4. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
