[1] The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*Mandamus*' directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6.

[2] Notice of motion.

[3] On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aashish Bishnoi, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 3-State and submits that as per the instructions, the Station House Officer, Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat-respondent No. 3 has been informed by Meena-respondent No. 4 (mother of petitioner No. 1), Yashpal-respondent No. 5 (father of petitioner No. 1) and Manjet Singh-respondent No. 6 (uncle of petitioner No.1) have no objection if the petitioners have got married. A copy of the '*Pairavi Report*' has been submitted by learned State counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record.

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[3.1] Learned State counsel has further submitted that the representation filed by the petitioner has already been decided after recording the statements of the private respondents No. 4 to 6. Copies of the said statements have also been submitted in Court. The same are also taken on record.

[4] Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Station House Officer, Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat (respondent No. 3) in case they still persist any further apprehension, at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6.
