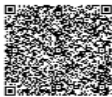
1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents to take appropriate legal action in the matter in view of complaint dated 15.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) against imminent threat to the peaceful life, liberty and livelihood of the petitioners, especially of petitioner no.3 and all requests and persuasions for peaceful resolution between the couple including complaint (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the dispute is purely of matrimonial nature and the petitioners want to amicably resolve the same. He submits that the petitioner no.3 has already submitted a complaint/representation dated 15.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner no.3 is in abroad and he is ready to appear in any inquiry / investigation through Video Conferencing.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Raj Karan Singh, Asstt. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2- the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Incharge Women Cell, SAS



Nagar, Mohali, to decide the complaint/representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. Counsel for the petitioners is further directed to get join petitioner no.3, who is in abroad, through Video Conferencing, in case of any inquiry / investigation.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
