1. Petitioner "Gxxx" has filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to conduct fair inquiry and take legal action against respondent No. 4 Amandeep Singh in FIR No. 288 dated 09.11.2024 under Section 376 of IPC registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) or any other direction which the Court may deem fit in the given facts and circumstances of case.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that FIR was lodged on 09.11.2024 and after passing of six months, no legal action has been taken, as a result, present petition has been filed.

3. Status report has been filed, according to which for the investigation in this case Special Investigating Team (SIT) was constituted by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala vide order dated 26.11.2024. During investigation, it was revealed that FIR No. 180 dated 13.08.2024 was registered under Section 109, 351(3), 324(4), 126(2), 309(4),



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191(2), 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Patran, District Patiala and in order to pressurize the respondent No. 4, present FIR has been registered. Special Investigating Team recommended to cancel present FIR No. 288 dated 09.11.2024 under Section 376 of IPC registered against respondent No. 4 at Police Station Tripuri, Patiala. Cancellation report was prepared on 27.07.2025. As per instructions of Inspector Sukhwinder Singh Gill, it is presented before the Court concerned on 19.08.2025 and next date fixed in this case is 03.10.2025.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, it is clear that cancellation report has been presented on 19.08.2025. Learned counsel representing petitioner is also informed about the next date of hearing. In the light of this, no further direction is required. Petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate legal remedy available to her as per law.

5. With aforesaid observation, petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
