SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India to protect the life and liberty of the Petitioner, by issuing appropriate directions to Respondents as the Petitioner is facing continuous threats at the behest of Respondents No. 7 to 9 who are police officials, powerful individuals wielding undue influence; to direct the official Respondents to take legal action against the Respondents no. 7 to 9 in relation to the offences perpetrated upon the Petitioner, as detailed in the Petition, including harassment, threat, illegal detention and confinement of the Petitioner, in interest of justice; to take appropriate action on the Representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) sent by the Petitioner in relation to the threats being faced by him at the behest of Respondents No. 7 to 9, in interest of justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-6), within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3/Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks by passing a speaking order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
