1. The petitioner incarcerated in the FIR captioned above, has come up before this Court under Section 483 BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail and an application bearing CRM-19561-2025 also filed for an ad-interim bail on medical ground
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was earlier granted bail on medical ground and he has surrendered and petitioner wants to implant an artificial limb and he has referred to documents in this regard as Annexure P-5 at page 65 which is letter dated 01.04.2025 by Cluster Manager, Clinical Services I Delhi Clinic, Otto Bock HealthCare India.
3. I have perused medical record of the petitioner including Annexure P-5.
4. State counsel opposes the bail, however, she seeks time to verify the authenticity of the medical record of the petitioner.
5. Medical history of petitioner shows that he requires some time to get implant an artificial limb and is entitled for interim bail.
6. Given above, provided the petitioner is not required in any other case, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail in the FIR captioned above subject to furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Court and due to unavailability before any nearest Ilaqa Magistrate/duty Magistrate. Before accepting the surety, the concerned Court must be satisfied that if the accused fails to appear, such surety can produce the accused.



7. While furnishing a personal bond, the petitioner shall mention the following personal identification details:

1.	AADHAR number	
2.	Passport number (If available) and when the attesting officer/court considers it appropriate or considers the accused a flight risk.	
3.	Mobile number (If available)	
4.	E-Mail id (If available)	

8. Any observation made hereinabove is neither an expression of opinion on the merits of the case nor shall the trial Court advert to these comments.

9. The petitioner shall surrender in prison from where he was released, on 04.07.2025 at 11.00 A.M.

10. It is clarified that petitioner shall also send copy of all the medical record documents qua implant of artificial limb for which reason, this Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner to the investigator/SHO concerned.

11. There would be no need for a certified copy of this order for furnishing bonds, and any Advocate for the Petitioner can download this order along with case status from the official web page of this Court and attest it to be a true copy. In case the attesting officer wants to verify the authenticity, such an officer can also verify its authenticity and may download and use the downloaded copy for attesting bonds.

12. CRM-19561-2025 stands allowed to the extent above. It is clarified that no application for extension of interim bail shall be filed in the present petition. Main petition stands disposed of with liberty to file fresh after surrender. However, in case, petitioner’s health does not improve then he shall be permitted to file a fresh petition for regular bail without surrendering. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
