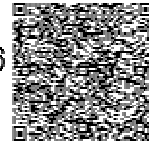

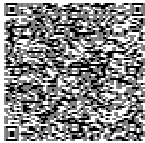

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuing direction to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 and also to decide the representation dated 06.05.2025 submitted by him.

2. Reply has been filed by the respondent-State. It is argued by learned State counsel that thorough inquiry has been conducted on the representation submitted by the petitioner but he could not produce any evidence or material to support his allegations before S.P. (Detective), Barnala. In fact, four cases have been registered against the petitioner himself and he has filed the present petition to obstruct the ongoing trial against him.

3. Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner could not submit anything supporting the claim of the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petition and the same is disposed.

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5. In compliance with order dated 01.08.2025, respondent No. 2 has submitted his explanation and request for exempting his personal appearance before this Court. The same is accepted. However, he is directed to be cautious and prompt in future.
