1. The present petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.153 dated 10.12.2024 under Sections 80, 85, 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Dehlon, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is in custody for 1 month and 15 days and it is a case where the petitioner is the cousin of the husband of the deceased and in fact in the FIR number of such relatives and cousins were roped in who had filed separate bail petitions before this Court which have already been allowed by this Court by way of a common order (Annexure P-2) and the petitioner is at parity with the aforesaid co-accused. He further submitted that considering the fact that the petitioner is at parity with the aforesaid co-accused, he may also be

considered for grant of regular bail.

3. Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, learned AAG, Punjab submitted that it is correct that the petitioner is at parity with the aforesaid co-accused, who have already been extended the benefit of regular bail by this Court vide Annexure P-2.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, since the petitioner is at parity with the aforesaid co-accused, who have already been granted regular bail, this Court is of the view that he also deserves the concession of regular bail. Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, if not required in any other case.

5. However, anything observed hereinabove shall not be treated as an expression of opinion on merits of the case and is only meant for the purpose of decision of present petition.
