1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that raising their grievance, the petitioners have moved representations dated 09.04.2025, 17.04.2025, 18.04.2025 and 03.05.2025 (Annexures P-1 to P-5) before various police authorities in the State of Haryana but no action has been taken thereupon by any of the Authority till date.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hansi, to look into the representation dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
4. Notice of motion.



5. On asking of the Court, Ms.Ankita Ahuja, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

6. At this stage, Mr.Amardeep Sheoran, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.5 and files vakalatnama in the Court, which is taken on record.

7. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hansi, to look into the representation dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and take immediate appropriate action, if required, in accordance with law within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
