Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner from respondents No.3 to 5 (parents and brother of the petitioner).

The petitioner has stated that she is having threat perception at the hands of private respondents No.3 to 5. Her parents and brother are coercing her to get married against her will and accord. As per Annexure P3 her date of birth is 31.12.2002 and she is above age of 18 years. It has been further stated that she has already moved a representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 and she would be satisfied if the aforesaid representation is decided.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that he has not objection if the aforesaid representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) is decided.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2—Police Commissioner, Mini Secretariat, Ferozepur Road, Ludhiana, to look into the representation dated 05.05.2025 Annexure P-2, at the earliest, regarding threat perception and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents No.3 to 5. However, it will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
