Application is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions. Written statement filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is taken on record. Registry is directed to do the needful.

Main case:

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 15.10.2010 with a prayer for issuance of directions to the respondent-Corporation to make regular recruitment to the post of Watchman and to discontinue the employment of SPOs/Home Guards for the purpose of watching the godown in the State of Punjab.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that so far as the aforesaid aspect is concerned, since the respondents are no more engaging the SPOs, hence, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. He further submits that grievance as regards seeking regular appointment(s) still subsists and he thus seeks withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to file an appropriate petition for aforesaid remaining relief after noticing and considering the interregnum developments, if so advised.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
