The prayer in this third petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 23.05.2021 registered under Section 307, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 & 27 of Arms Act at police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

As per the allegations the petitioner along with his co-accused fired gunshots on the injured, though the petitioner himself has not been attributed any injury.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant has turned hostile and the matter stands compromised between the parties. Therefore, this petitioner be granted bail.



The Counsel for the complainant admits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

I have heard counsel for the parties.

Though the allegations against the petitioner and his co-accused are very serious, firstly complainant has not supported the prosecution case and secondly a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. In this situation the further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-**Harphool Singh @ Bharpoor Singh** son of Sh. Prem Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition stand disposed of.
