1. The prayer is to issue writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to take steps for cancellation of the license granted to respondent No.3 who is alleged to have obtained the license of practice as an Advocate after obtaining fake, forged and fabricated decree from respondent No.2.

2. Mr. Aman Sharma, Advocate, enters appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and submits that no representation has been received from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is required to file a complaint under Chapter-I Part VII of the Bar Council of India Rules. He further submits that the moment the complaint is filed in the prescribed proforma, necessary action shall be taken expeditiously.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid statement of the learned counsel representing the respondent No.1, this writ petition is disposed of while

granting liberty to the petitioner to file a complaint in the prescribed proforma within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, which shall be considered by the competent authority, expeditiously.
