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**KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)**

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondent No.3-State Registrar, Firms and Societies, Haryana, to hear and decide the appeal No.17 of 2025, along with the stay application, and other pending applications.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion, by drawing an order dated 13.05.2025, this Court, had passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant writ petition :-

*“Through the instant petition prayer is made for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 – State Registrar Firms and Societies, Haryana to hear and decide the appeal No. 17 of 2025, along with the stay application, and other applications, if any, wherethrough the quashing of order dated 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) and order dated*



*28.01.2022 (Annexure P-2), as passed by the District Registrar Kurukshetra- respondent No.4, has been sought. Notice of motion for 21.05.2025.*

*Mr. Bhupender Singh, learned DAG, Haryana accepts notice qua respondents No. 1 to 6 and waives service on their behalf.*

*Notice to respondents No. 7 to 31, subject to furnishing requisite process fee by the petitioner for the date fixed. Process dasti as well.*

*On the next date of hearing, learned State counsel shall inform this Court, after having apt instructions from the respondent No.3 – State Registrar Firms and Societies, Haryana, as to how much time is required to decide the appeal (supra).”*

3. Today, learned counsel for the State, on instructions imparted to him by Mr. Susheel, Industrial Extension Officer, informs this Court, that within the next two months, the appeal (supra), and all other pending applications thereto, would be finally decided, by the respondent No.3.

4. In view of the above statement, as made by the learned State counsel, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant writ petition, and the same is hereby, **closed**.

5. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
