Prayer made in the present writ petition is for directing the respondent to consider the claim of promotion of the petitioner being most eligible and considering the APAR marks of financial year 2021-22.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that at this juncture the petitioner(s) would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the competent authority to decide the claim of the petitioner submitted through E-mails (Annexure P-5) sent by him by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
