1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the police official to consider the pending representations dated 03.05.2024 and 16.05.2024 (P-3 & P-4) for protection of life and liberty of petitioners and their family members who are under imminent danger from the hands of Land Mafia connived with respondent No.3, who are extending continuous threat to petitioners.

2. Learned State counsel refers to the status report and submits that the present petition filed by the petitioners is totally misconceived as the threat perception of the petitioners was dispassionately assessed by senior police officer of the rank of Additional Superintendent of Police, Karnal. It was found that civil litigation is pending between the petitioners and private respondents and there is no bit of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. The apprehension raised by the petitioners is fanciful and fair inquiry has been conducted. Furthermore, no cognizable offence is found to have been committed.

3. In view of the status report submitted on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the same stands disposed of.
