1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue directios to respondents to grant the Police Clearance Certificate (P.C.C) to the petitioner in view of the status in a cross case registered vide G.D No.44, dated 16.06.2020, under Sections 324,323, 148 and 149 of IPC in FIR No. 46, dated 16.06.2020, under Sections 447,511,379,323,34 of IPC (Annexure P-1), Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the investigation in the above mentioned cross version has already been conducted by the police and the petitioner has been found innocent, during the course of investigation.

3. On the other hand learned State counsel on instructions from S.S.P Ludhiana (Rural) submits that the petitioner has been found innocent, during the course of investigation, however, he has not applied for grant of P.C.C

before the competent authority. In case, any such application is received by the competent authority, the matter shall be considered and the P.C.C shall be granted within a period of one week thereafter.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the competent authority for issuance of the Police Clearance Certificate (P.C.C).

5. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
